^Minimum height of child is 140 cm; they need to operate the Kart independently.

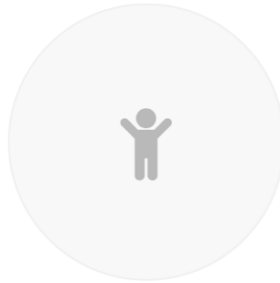
